Children who are read to regularly exhibit higher activation in areas of the brain that support mental imagery and comprehension of narratives — key skills needed for independent reading comprehension. Story Times incorporate the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read. Library programs have significant positive impacts on early development and help equip children with lifelong learning and literacy skills that help prepare them for school and beyond.






## Mon., Oct. 17 at 10:30 AM and Thurs., Oct. 20 at 5:00 PM



A lonely witch looking for friends gets *Lots of Cats* in this week's story by E. Dee Taylor. We'll make our black cat friend to take home.


### Mon., Oct. 24 at 10:30 AM and Thurs., Oct. 27 at 5:00 PM



First we'll read about Sheep Trick or Treat, then we'll do our own trick or treating after we decorate our own trick or treat bags. Wear a


costume to Story Time!

Who-whoooo is ready to make an autumn owl craft? We'll we read *Little Owl's Night* by Divya Srinivasan.


# Mon., Nov. 21 at 10:30 AM and Thurs., Nov. 24 at 5:00 PM
